#### RESEARCH RESULTS II.

- Not aware with the term cyberbullying
- Online harassment



- Prefer adult help instead of peer support
- Changing school as a solution
- 2 ongoing cases were revealed
  - 33 settled cases were mentioned

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Define cyberbullying
- Amend the Act on Education with Annex IX.
  - Acknowledge the existence of bullying and cyberbullying
  - Require each school to introduce anti-bullying program
  - Include the definition of cyberbullying
