Conditions for application: minimum 4.5 traditional grade point average (equivalent to 90% of the 100% academic achievement of the Faculty)

I. Studies (max. 30 points)

Academic performance: based on the applicant's corrected credit index

4,00 - 4,4: 5 points

4,41 - 4,8: 7 points

4,81 - 5,2: 11 points

5,21 - 5,5: 15 points

5,51 - 6: 20 points

Language examinations: language examinations other than the language of the program and/or in addition to the diploma requirement

Intermediate A or B: 2 - 2 points

 C: 4 points

Advanced A or B: 3 - 3 points

 C: 6 points

II. Professional activities (max. 60 points)

In the professional activities category, points may be awarded for professional activity connected to the undergraduate programs of the University of Szeged since students submit their applications at the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences. Outstanding achievement at other universities or in postgraduate and doctoral programs will not be taken into account during the evaluation process.

OTDK (National Scientific Students' Associations Conference) placement and participation, and placement and participation in international and national scientific competitions:

OTDK - opponent - 3 points

TDK (Scientific Students' Associations) membership: 2 points (regardless of the number of TDKs attended)

Scientific publications:

Published in a journal/edited volume in a language other than the applicant's native language - 6 points

Published in a journal/edited volume in than applicant's native language - 4 points

Published in a faculty/university journal/edited volume (regardless of the language) - 3 points

Scientific presentations:

Conference presentation in a language other than the applicant's native language, outside the Faculty - 6 points

Conference presentation in the applicant's native language, outside the Faculty - 4 points

Presentation at the Faculty - 3 points

Other academic presentation - 2 points

Other professional or academic competitions:
