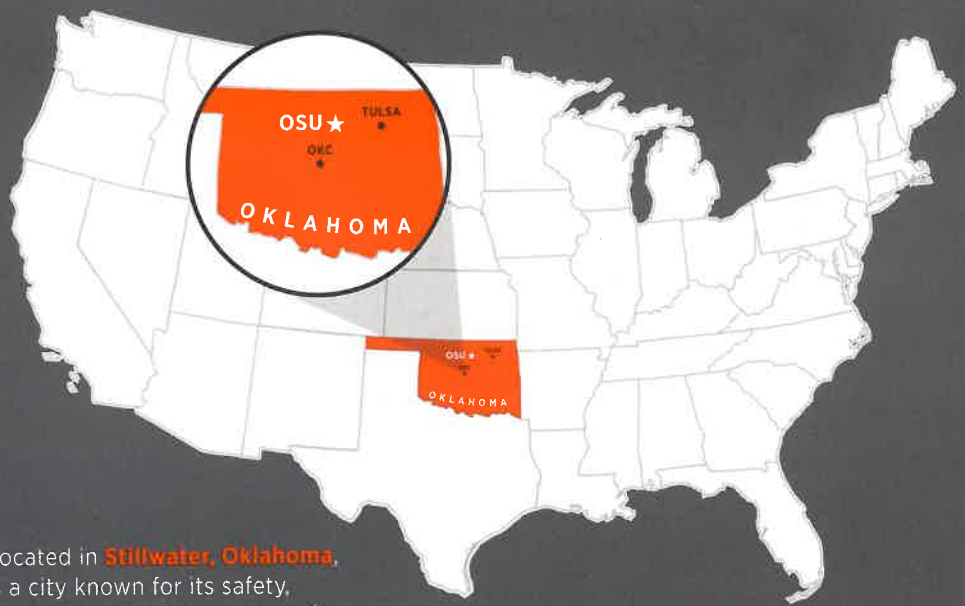

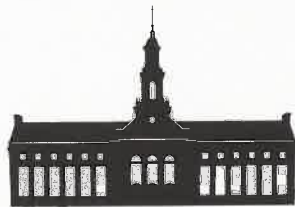

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

English-language proficiency exams
TOEFL iBT Score: 61+ **or** IELTS Score: 5.5+ **AND** High school GPA: 3.0+
(based on a 4.0 scale)

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

OSU offers conditional admission to students who meet all admission requirements except the English language proficiency requirement.

Upon submission of scores meeting assured criteria **and/or** successful completion of 12 weeks of advanced English language training from an accredited English language institute, students will be fully admitted to OSU. Visit okla.st/conditional for more information.
